LACHLAN MASSEY | GUEST CONDUCTOR

Lachlan is Artistic Associate at Gondwana Choirs, working under Lyn Williams AM. In his time with the choirs he has prepared them for performances with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, Sydney Theatre Company and for six Prime Ministers of Australia. Recent highlights include preparing the children's choruses in *Julia*, directed by Sarah Goodes for Sydney Theatre Company, and *The Chronicles* for Sydney Festival and Stephanie Lake Company. As a composer and director of opera, and especially those for young audiences, Lachlan's productions with Musgrove Opera have been called "ingenious...petite productions for hungry young minds" (Time Out). The company has performed children's operas such to packed houses at The Concourse and the Sydney Opera House, as well as regional venues. Its schools concerts have been well received by teachers and students alike, bringing energetic productions to classrooms and school halls of all shapes and sizes. His stage works as a composer include *Pinocchio!* (2018), *Mulga Bill's Bicycle* (The Concourse, 2024), *Hansel and Gretel* (The Concourse, 2021), and as music director; *Aija Draguns' Max and Moritz* (Sydney Opera House, 2022), and *Malcolm Fox's Sid the Serpent who Wanted to Sing* (Sydney Opera House, 2022/23). In 2026 his children's opera *Lennie Gwyther's Great Adventure* will premiere at the Sydney Opera House prior to a regional tour.

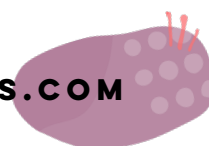


Lachlan is a primary music teacher at SCEGGS Darlinghurst and Director of Choirs at Shore School. He has presented workshops for ACO Foundations and has been a guest conductor for the RSCM Junior Schools Choral Festival and NSW State Music Camps, and the Festival of Choral Music (The Arts Unit). Lachlan is a former Young Ambassador for the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, and a graduate of the Sydney Conservatorium of Music.

MICHAEL POWER | ACCOMPANIST

Michael Power is a collaborative pianist and teacher in Hobart. He completed a Bachelor of Music with Dr Gian-Franco Ricci and Helen English at the Newcastle Conservatorium of Music, during which time he was awarded the Nan Price Memorial Scholarship. Michael specialised in chamber music and collaborative piano studies with Gabriella Pusner in the Honours program, and attended the Accademia Europea di Firenze Intensive Winter School.

Michael has performed with artists such as Sally Walker and Andy Firth, and performed newly commissioned works by Australian composers including Elena Kats-Chernin, Paul Jarman, Don Kay, and Jim Coyle. He held the position of School Accompanist and Teacher of Piano at Newcastle Grammar School for 14 years, with which he toured as pianist to the USA and China, and held a similar position at the Newcastle Conservatorium of Music.





Michael was the Vice President of Music Teachers' Association of NSW and served as the President of the Newcastle Branch, where he gave regular masterclasses, adjudicated competitions, and performed on local radio. He was a foundation member of the Newcastle Youth Orchestra, later holding the position as Manager. In 2019, Michael was a Community Director's Award Program Recipient and subsequently holds a Diploma of Business (Governance) in Arts leadership, and a Masters of Teaching (Secondary) from UTAS.

Since relocating to Hobart in 2020, Michael continues his work as both piano teacher and collaborative pianist. He performs at the Festival of Voices, and is a repetiteur and orchestral pianist with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and Chorus. Michael was the founding pianist for JESSA, former President of the Tasmanian Music Teachers' Association and is currently the Head of Music at The Friends School.

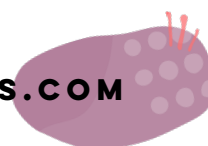
THE TASMANIAN YOUTH ORCHESTRAS

The Tasmanian Youth Orchestra is TYO's flagship ensemble, providing exceptional development opportunities and outstanding performance experiences for the past 60 years. The accomplished young musicians in this orchestra range in age from 12 to 25 and represent some of Tasmania's finest young musical talent. Musicians in this orchestra have the opportunity to rehearse weekly with their musical peers, perform challenging symphonic repertoire at least three times per year; and collaborate annually with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra through TSO's 'Big Rehearsal'.



TYO CHIEF CONDUCTOR: THOMAS RIMES

Thomas Rimes is a Tasmanian musician who has worked throughout Europe, the United States, China and Australia as an operatic and symphonic conductor and as a composer/arranger of numerous stage works. From 2009-19 he was engaged as a Kapellmeister (staff conductor) at opera houses in the German cities of Kassel and Gelsenkirchen. Having now returned to Australia, he currently works as the Director of Music at St. David's Cathedral in Hobart, the Director of Ensembles at Sacred Heart College and as a frequent guest conductor with ensembles such as the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and the Sydney Youth Orchestra. His most recent major stage composition, the mock-baroque comic opera "Annus Horribilis" was premiered to great acclaim in April 2023.
